

# OgSport Lu

Activity during the week was confined to the U7 age group and to the VHI Cul Camps. The U7 Regional Blitz was hosted by five clubs – Naomh Feichin, Oliver Plunkets, Sean McDermotts, Clann na nGael and Roche Emmetts and the Cul Camps were based at Roche Emmetts (Football) with Eamonn Reilly the co-ordinator, St.Kevins (Camgie) with Eithne Murray the co-ordinator and Collon (Football) with Mark Lacey the co-ordinator.

## OgSport Lu and the Cul camps

These Vhi GAA Cul Camps complement the work of OgSport Lu-who run games in the county for U7, U9, U11 and U134 age groups-and support effective and efficient coaching and games. While the games are still competitive the pressure of winning at all costs is removed and more emphasis is placed on player development, which is more enjoyable for the children.

The camps run from 10am-2.30pm each day and are open to boys and girls from 7-13 years of age. The programme involves coaching specific skills of the game and gives the opportunity for children to put in to practice what they have learned through small-sided Go Games and mini-leagues with greater emphasis on conditioned games that have more intensity, more scoring chances and more decision making. There are no subs.So therefore, nobody is left behind; parents and players go home happy.

Throughout the morning our coaches tutor the children in all the basic and some advanced skills of Gaelic Games. The FUNdamentals is an important factor here concentrating on Agility, Balance and Coordination along with Catching, Kicking, Striking, Throwing & Passing. All that hard work is then all capped off with the ever-popular Skills Competition before lunch.

Come Friday, after the presentation ceremony where every child receives a certificate and medal, they will have had an action packed week incorporating the skills, games, fun and excitement that goes hand in hand with the GAA. Each child will receive their very own Cul Camp jersey, shorts socks, Cul Camp Kit bag, Medal and certificate.
