Want to be part of the fun?

We are looking for **Clubs/Organisations/Charities** to take part in the event. To enter you will need 10 players to make up your team. There is €2000 in prize money up for grabs. In addition to this you have the opportunity to raise funds for your chosen **Club/Charity/Organisation**.

How to enter

Each team consists of 10 players costing €25 per player i.e. €250 per team. This is payable in advance of the event to secure teams place.

Once registered, you will receive a sponsorship pack containing sponsor cards for each member to raise funds for your chosen **Charity/Club/Organisation**.

Our main aim of this event is to raise money for Charities such as: The Irish Cancer Society, Down Syndrome Ireland & Suicide awareness

For this reason we ask for 10% of all sponsorship your team receives to be donated to the above charities, all other money raised by you is for your own **Charity/Club/Organisation**.

Please see below for possible projected income for your club/ charity:

- Team sponsorship e.g. local business: €250 (If your team is sponsored by a company this will not come out of your money raised)
- Sponsorship: 10 people raise €200 each = €2000
Less 10% (Charitable donation) = €200
- Prize Money to Winner = €2000
- Projected total income for winning team = €3800
- Projected total income if you don't win, just had a great day = €1800

On Sunday evening there will be a **Presentation night** for the winners and runner up in the **Granvue House Hotel** at 8pm. There will be **music and refreshments** on the night.
